# State and Federal Guidance

- Assessments
  - State Assessments cancelled for 2019-2020
  - PSAT and SAT will not be given as originally planned this spring.
    - CDE is collaborating with College Board to identify a solution, particularly for high school juniors.
- Accountability
  - State accountability pause, similar to 2015-16 school year





# Graduation

- Local Graduation Requirements
  - CDE is encouraging flexibility in local graduation requirements for the class of 2020
  - Graduation requirements may be modified at the district level
- Graduation Ceremonies
  - Governor Polis has asked schools not to hold traditional in-person ceremonies
  - PSD is brainstorming options for in-person and virtual graduation ceremonies





# Instructional Support

- Instructional Time Waivers
  - CDE is providing a statewide waiver from instructional hours and days requirements outlined in statute
- Attendance
  - CDE will not require submission or tracking of attendance
- Grades and Grade-Level Promotions
  - Local districts will make determinations about whether/how to assign grades and will make decisions about grade-level promotions
  - PSD will provide report cards to elementary and secondary students



# PSD Construction Update

- New School Buildings
  - Construction of SE Elementary, Wellington MS/HS, Prospect MS/HS continuing as plans
    - Delays are not currently anticipated
    - PSD is working closely with our contractors to continually assess the impacts of COVID-19 on these projects
  - Design of Transportation Facility to be completed; construction to be paused





# PSD Construction Update

- Renovations/Improvements to Existing Buildings
  - All Spring Break projects were completed
  - Front of Classroom installs are continuing
  - All renovation/improvement projects from the \$40M list currently under contract and planned for summer 2020 will continue
