Re: Information Item: Graduation Guidelines

At the July 2020 State Board of Education meeting, CDE staff will provide an informational presentation about graduation guidelines and implementation feasibility for the 2020-21 school year.

This information item will provide background for the State Board of Education (SBE) on Colorado's graduation guidelines, which are scheduled for implementation in the 2020-21 school year. C.R.S. 22-2-106(a.5) states that graduation guidelines are "a comprehensive set of guidelines for the establishment of high school graduation requirements to be used by each school district board of education in developing local high school graduation requirements." The guidelines are expectations for high school seniors to show their skills and competencies in English and math in alignment with career and college readiness.

Due to the disruption of COVID-19, CDE staff will outline the logistical challenges with implementation for the 2020-21 school year and share options for the SBE to consider, including modifying the menu for 2020-21, with full implementation in 2021-22.
